

The ORGATEC TOKYO success story enters its second round

ORGATEC TOKYO 2023 will be held in Halls 1 and 2 of Tokyo Big Sight West from 26 to 28 April. The show will feature nearly 130 exhibitors from Japan and abroad, occupying an area almost twice the size of the occupied space in 2022. Among the exhibitors are top brands such as Okamura, Kokuyo, Itoki, Uchida Yoko, Plus, Karimoku Furniture, Knoll, Wilkhahn, CITTERIO, Draft, Häfele. New products and ideas for the future of work will be presented and discussed by a wide range of furniture and office design professionals, including architects, interior designers and developers. This year's theme [SHIFT DESIGN] explores how good design can influence and change ever-changing societies, work and lifestyles for the better.

Varied supporting programme accompanies product exhibition

The "Xperience Area" produced by the fair organiser Koelnmesse will include a spacious biophilic garden highlighting the connection between work, design and nature. Top brands such as Okamura, Kokuyo and Itoki will give presentations there on their visions of the future of work. In addition, seminars with up-and-coming designers and creatives will be held there. Furthermore, the fair will hold a competition for stand design with the "Best Presentation Award", which will recognise the stands that best embody the theme [SHIFT DESIGN]. The stands will be judged on the basis of five criteria: Overall Concept, Design, Functionality, Originality and Sustainability. The Grand Prize and runners-up are selected by a prestigious selection committee that includes architects Yuko Nagayama and Astrid Klein, among others.

The ORGATEC TOKYO "Xperience Area" will also include a "+W" (adding work) Showcase, which will explore how best to combine workspaces with living, dining and kitchen spaces. This +W area will feature products from various brands that aim to unite work and living spaces for the home office of the future.

On 26 April, renowned interior designer Primo Orpilla will open ORGATEC TOYKO 2023 with a keynote speech. Primo Orpilla is the founder of Studio O+A and has designed many cutting-edge offices, including the offices of McDonald's, Adidas and Slack. The talk will focus on the next generation of office design reflected in his work.

On the evening of the first two days of the fair, 26 and 27 April, Koelnmesse and the Japan Office and Institutional Furniture Association (JOIFA) will host [ORGATEC NIGHT], an after-hour event where guests from different countries and sectors can meet in a relaxed atmosphere and make new, high-quality contacts. There will also be a surprise event on 27 April.
